

Corn Weed Emergence Timeline

When Yield-Robbing Weeds Typically Emerge in the Midwest

EMERGES FULLY IN FALL OR EARLY SPRING



Marestail (horseweed)

Fully emerges in fall or early spring ahead of corn planting.

EMERGE IN SPRING AHEAD OF CORN PLANTING



Common lambsquarters

Can emerge prior to corn planting and well into the season.



Giant ragweed

Can emerge prior to corn planting and well into the season.



Kochia

Can emerge prior to corn planting and well into the season with multiple flushes.

EMERGE AT CORN PLANTING



Palmer amaranth

Can emerge at corn planting and well into the season with multiple flushes.



Waterhemp

Can emerge at corn planting and well into the season with multiple flushes.



Giant foxtail

Can emerge at corn planting and for about two months after.



Common ragweed

Can emerge at corn planting and for about one month after.

EMERGES AFTER CORN EMERGENCE



Morningglory

Can emerge following corn emergence for about two months after.
