

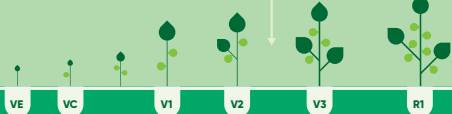

Preferred application window for FeXapan[®] herbicide



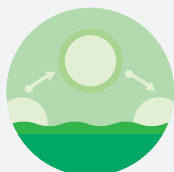
Application window

Apply in Roundup Ready 2 Xtend[®] soybeans up to R1 growth stage or 45 days after planting, whichever comes first.



Weed height

Apply when weeds are no more than 4 inches tall for best results.



Time of day

Apply only during the day, from one hour after sunrise through two hours before sunset.

Training is required

DuPont[™] FeXapan[®] herbicide Plus VaporGrip[®] Technology can be applied only by certified applicators. Before spraying the product, the applicator must complete annual, mandatory dicamba or auxin-specific training.

Observe



Wind speed

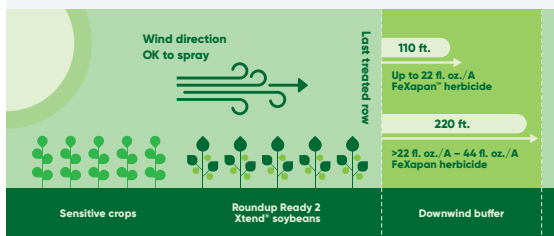
Apply when wind speed, measured at boom height, is between 3 and 10 mph.

Avoid inversions

Do not spray into a temperature inversion.

Sensitive crops

Do not spray when wind is blowing toward adjacent sensitive crops.



Buffers required

Maintain the required 110-foot downwind buffer for all applications at 22 fl. oz./A.

Check the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency's online Endangered Species Protection Bulletins for the county where you plan to apply for potential additional buffer requirements.

Apply

Application rate

Spray at 22 fl. oz./A for all single, in-crop applications to dicamba-tolerant crops.



Spray volume

Apply a minimum of 15 GPA solution.

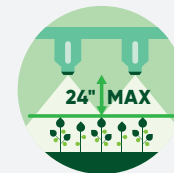
Tank-mix products

Use only qualified tank-mix partners, and never include ammonium sulfate or ammonium sulfate-based additives in any tank mix with FeXapan herbicide Plus VaporGrip Technology.



Nozzles and operating pressure

Use only qualified nozzles and corresponding operating pressures.



Boom height

Keep boom height no more than 24 inches above a target weed or crop canopy.



Ground speed

Do not exceed 15 mph ground speed.

Equipment cleanout

Thoroughly clean entire spray system and all handling equipment before and after using FeXapan[®] herbicide Plus VaporGrip[®] Technology to avoid contamination.

Record keeping

Application records for every separate application of FeXapan herbicide Plus VaporGrip Technology must be kept for two years.
