With Starane<sup>®</sup> Flex herbicide, wheat growers can close the door on tough weeds while leaving the door open to crop rotation flexibility.

### Control tough weeds that others miss.

Starane Flex controls many broadleaf weeds that current market standards miss — including wild buckwheat, large and ALS-resistant kochia, prickly lettuce and many more. Table 3 (reverse side) lists more tough weeds controlled by Starane Flex and shows how it compares with other leading herbicides.

### Maintain the flexibility to rotate to other crops.

There's low residual carryover with Starane Flex, so growers can rotate to any crop the following season. This includes the flexibility of rotating from cereals to pulse crops or potatoes — and making the most of market opportunities.

### Get flexible weed control and value options.

Growers know that weed control is a good investment. With its excellent weed control, and rotational and tank-mix flexibility (see Table 2), Starane Flex offers the opportunity for even greater value on more acres.

### Get flexible weed control and value options.

Apply to wheat (including spring, winter and durum), barley, oats, rye and triticale from three-leaf stage up to flag leaf emergence.

- Apply Starane<sup>®</sup> Flex herbicide postemergence to target susceptible broadleaf weeds up to 4 inches tall.
- Apply 13.5 fl. oz./A by ground in a spray volume of 10 gallons or more per acre.
- Starane Flex is rainfast within four hours of application.
