|----------------------------------|--|---|
| Annual and biennial weeds | 2 | Apply to annual weeds when small and actively growing |
| Perennial weeds | 2 - 4 | Apply to perennial weeds from bud to bloom stage |

*The lower use rates will be satisfactory for young, succulent growth of sensitive weed species. For less sensitive species and under conditions where control is more difficult, higher use rates in the rate range are recommended.
