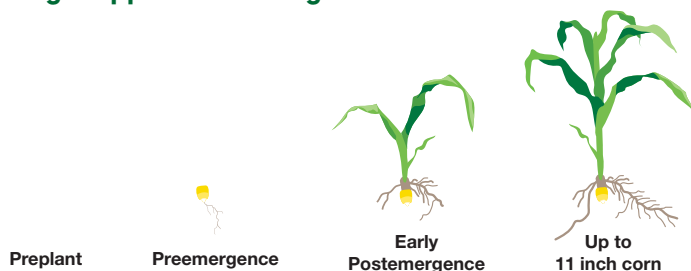

Count on Keystone® LA NXT herbicide for consistent control of both large- and small-seeded broadleaf weeds in areas where atrazine use is restricted or where lower atrazine rates are desired due to risk of carryover.

Providing dependable and flexible control

- Keystone LA NXT provides excellent control of annual grasses and broadleaf weeds, including foxtails, barnyardgrass, crabgrass, waterhemp, lambsquarters, pigweeds, nightshade and many more.
- Designed with a lower rate of atrazine than Keystone NXT herbicide, so it can be used in atrazine- restricted areas.
- Easy to handle and less viscous than other soil-applied premixes.
- The dual modes of action provide control of difficult-to- control and herbicide-resistant weeds.
- Requires only ¼ inch of rain for activation.
- It can be applied from early preplant to early postemergence in conventional, reduced-till and no-till corn production systems.
- It can be used alone or in combination with many pre- and postemergence corn herbicides.

Use rates by soil texture content in conventional tillage systems

Soil Texture	Broadcast Rate per Acre (Quarts)*
Coarse	1.8 qt.
Medium	1.8 – 2.3 qt.
Fine	2.0 – 2.3 qt.

*Use the higher rate in the rate range in areas of heavy weed infestation.

NOTE: In areas of heavy weed infestations, use up to 2.7 quarts per acre on medium- and fine-textured soils.

¹ Apply 2.7 quarts of Keystone LA NXT per acre to control this weed; control can be erratic, especially under dry conditions. Control escaped weeds with cultivation or application of an appropriate registered postemergence herbicide.

² Preplant incorporate for improved control.

³ Use the higher rate in the recommended application rate range. Activity may be reduced under dry conditions or following early (more than 14 days) preplant applications. Additional atrazine and/or sequential herbicides may be needed for complete control.

⁴ Best control is achieved when Keystone LA NXT is applied within 5 days of planting and rainfall occurs shortly after application or mechanical incorporation is used to activate the herbicide. If rainfall does not occur within 7 days after application, shallow cultivation will enhance activity. Excessive rainfall after application may reduce control. Under adverse weather conditions and/or heavy infestations, a cultivation or follow-up herbicide application may be needed.
